Certificate III in Individual Support

If you enjoy working with the older members of our community, these courses will give you the knowledge, skills and qualifications to work in this sector.

These certificate qualifications can assist you to gain work in the community sector or in an aged care facility, in a range of occupational titles which may include:

- Care assistant / worker
- Home maintenance worker
- Care service employees
- In-home respite worker
- Community care worker
- Personal care assistant
- Community support worker
- Disability support worker
- Planned activity assistant
- Support worker
- Home care worker

These courses require a minimum of 6 months commitment from students. Our training days are Wednesday and Thursday from 12— 4 pm. There is also a self-paced assessment for each of the 13 units which comprise this qualification.

Ongoing observation and assessment from our trainers and assessors supports each student's progression throughout the course. If required, we offer a comprehensive mentor program to enable students to fulfil the course commitments with confidence.

Our study days are designed for students to come in and enjoy peer group support or individual assistance, work together and share ideas.

A work placement component at the end of the course enables you to develop and practice the skills and knowledge you have gained throughout the course. During the work placement there will be continued liaison with a qualified trainer and assessor to monitor your progress.

Students are required to have sound reading and writing skills to enable them to understand the content of the course.

Your role as a certificate III worker will require you to communicate and support a wide range of people; including the elderly, people from other cultures, people with a disability, and people of all ages who require support.

COSTS

The full cost of the course is \$3500

Assistance with funding the course may be available for people who receive Centrelink or similar support. Please discuss this with us.

As part of our selection process, an (aged care compliant) current National Police Check is required from each student prior to commencement of the course.

We offer RPL to people who may have prior learning in this sector. Our trained staff will guide you with this.
